PGDBM (LOGISTICS & SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT) - XLRI & MS IN SUPPLY CHAIN ANALYTICS - RUTGERS BUSINESS SCHOOL, US

Background

PGDBM (Logistics & Supply Chain Management) from XLRI, Jamshedpur & MS in Supply Chain Analytics from Rutgers Business School, US is a Double Masters Program from two highly ranked institutions that have centers of excellence in supply chain and operations. The program is designed to provide students a fundamental understanding of a firm's logistics and supply chain management from a global perspective. Students will acquire professional competencies in supply chain management,

materials management & logistics, and an in-depth understanding of supply chain analytics enhancing their knowledge, job skills and self-enrichment.

This highly competitive program is best suited for those with a mindset to apply analytics to supply chain fields and be the future supply chain leaders. The program offers an opportunity to earn two masters degree collaborating with Rutgers Business School, US.

Structure of the programs

Students who are admitted in this programme will complete the first year of courses in XLRI Jamshedpur and the second year at Rutgers Business School, US as shown in the Table on Curriculum Structure. On successful completion of the required courses and other formalities as stipulated by the respective institutions, the students will be awarded PGDBM in LSCM from XLRI Jamshedpur and MS in SCA from RBS, US.

Eligibility

For this programme, minimum eligibility is a **three years of Bachelor's degree** in any discipline, recognized by a University or Deemed to be University and it should be from a **NAAC accredited institution with a rating of at least A**. For Engineering graduates of minimum 4 years from reputed institutions like IIT's, NIT's, etc., NAAC Accreditation is not mandatory. Those completing their final examination by June 10, 2022 may also apply. **Candidates with good work experience and sponsored candidates from organizations are also encouraged to apply.**

ADMISSION PROCESS FOR APPLYING TO XLRI JAMSHEDPUR

Candidates can apply for the double masters programme by applying through the website www.xlri.ac.in or <https://xlrij.in5.nopaperforms.com/>. The instructions for applying and registration are given on the website.

The selection criteria will be based on the Test scores of XAT/GMAT/GRE/GATE or any other quality tests approved by the institute. Shortlisted candidates will be called for interview.

In its pursuit of academic excellence, XLRI actively encourages the students from diverse backgrounds. While preparing the short-listed candidates for the interview, in addition to the submitted test scores, XLRI may factor in academic background and the relevant work experience. Besides performance in the personal interviews (and/or group discussions), we also consider Test scores performance, relevant work experience, academic background, extracurricular activities while preparing the final list.

Academic programme

The academic structure for the double masters program consists of the first year courses in XLRI Jamshedpur spread over three terms of each 10-12 weeks period during June 2022-March 2023, with a Summer Internship Programme in the areas of Logistics and Supply Chain Management during April-June 2023 and the second year courses spread over two semesters in the Rutgers Business School, USA from September 2023-May 2024. The transcripts of both the institutions will be exchanged between them to fulfil the respective diploma and degree requirements of both the institutions respectively.

During the first year of the Program, students learn basic concepts in the areas of Finance and Accounting, Human Resource Management, Marketing, Organizational Behaviour, Systems, Production and Quantitative Techniques and domain courses in the areas of logistics and supply chain management. During the study in the RBS, US, course curriculum of the MSCA of the RBS will be covered as shown in the Table on Curriculum Structure.

The core courses in the business management help students appreciate the interdependency of the various functional areas and integrate them while addressing problems in the business context while in specialized courses on supply chain management students can pursue specific courses dealing with the domain knowledge in the logistics and supply chain areas.

Summer Internship Programme

At the end of the first year, all students are required to undertake a project in an organization as an integral part of the curriculum in the areas of logistics and supply chain management. Students work on live assignments for various organizations which gives the students an opportunity to sharpen their knowledge and skills, develop better appreciation of the practical problems of business organizations in general and the management. The Summer Projects help the students plan their professional career in the light of the practical experience gained during the eight to ten-week period.

Team Building Exercise

Three-day team building component is compulsory for all the students of this program. The objective of the programme is to develop leadership and teamwork through exercises and assignments in the logistics and supply chain management areas.

An orientation programme will be conducted during June 2022. The objective of the programme is to

- (a) introduce the new members of the XL family to the culture and working ethos of this Institute.
- (b) to help the students identify their profile, and areas for self-development.
- (c) help the freshers for their successful stay at XLRI.

Academic Evaluation System

XLRI's evaluation system is designed to continually assess the students' performance in relation to the required standards of academic achievement. Apart from examinations, a student's performance is assessed based on class participation, preparation of periodic assignments, mid-term tests and surprise quizzes. The Institute expects a minimum standard for promotion to the second year and for the award of the Diploma. Failure to meet the minimum standards of performance at any time would require a student to discontinue from the programme. Minimum performance in the first year is also expected from the students to qualify to apply for the RBS Programme and for the scholarships as stipulated by the RBS, US.



ADMISSION PROCESS FOR APPLYING TO RBS, USA

Students in the RBS-XLRI double masters program should apply to the MSCA program after completing the required course at XLRI as specified in the Table on Curriculum Structure of the Double Masters Programme. The transcripts for the first two terms will be used to determine the level of scholarship for each student (See the section on Scholarship for students in the program for more details). The application period will start on March 1st, 2023, till end on May 7th, 2023.

The Checklist for Applying is as follows:

1. Application fee of \$70 is waived by RBS for this program
2. Official Transcripts of the first two terms at XLRI must be uploaded and any other transcripts for undergraduate and graduate institution attended
3. Standard Test Results (XAT, GMAT, GRE, GATE or any other that was approved and submitted to XLRI at the time of selection must be uploaded. There is no need to retake these tests.
4. English Language Test Results (TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE) are waived by RBS
5. Two letters of recommendation that are required are waived by RBS
6. Resume is required and to be uploaded
7. An essay of no more than two pages, stating your background, your career objectives upon graduating from the program, and why you are interested in studying supply chain analytics is required and to be uploaded
8. Video Interview is waived by RBS

The application period will start on March 1st, 2023, till end on May 7th, 2023.

Students should apply through the RBS application portal by clicking the link here: <https://www.business.rutgers.edu/masters-supply-chain-analytics/admissions>, and then select the RBS-XLRI double masters program.



Once the application is received, the admission and scholarship letters will be issued by June 1st, and the students will then upload other required documents for their I-20 (the list can be found here: <https://www.business.rutgers.edu/masters-supply-chain-analytics/international-applicants>).

A \$2,000 tuition deposit and \$800 orientation fee will also be waived for the students in the RBS-XLRI double masters program.

Once the admission and scholarship offer are accepted by the student, he/she will work with the Admission Office and the Office of International Student and Scholar Services (OISS) office of Rutgers University to start the I-20 and visa application process. Students will directly get in touch with the OISS Office for processing Visas.

INFORMATION TO STUDENTS

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STEM-OPT option

The MS-Supply Chain Analytics (MSCA) program at Rutgers is a STEM-designated program. As such, graduates from the program are eligible for a total of 3-year OPT upon graduation.

Optional Practical Training (OPT) is temporary employment directly related to an F-1 student's major area of study and is commensurate with the level of education being sought. An F-1 student may be authorized 12 months of OPT for study at one education level. An F-1 student with a degree majoring in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) may apply for an extension of an additional 24-month OPT while in a valid period of post-completion OPT as per the current rules in the US.

F1 students in the MSCA program should directly consult Rutgers Office of International Student and Scholar Services (OISS) regarding their I-20, F1 visa, OPT, and other related issues. The OISS-Newark website is: <https://myrun.newark.rutgers.edu/oiss>.

Fee Structure for the Double Masters Program

Tuition Fee for the Curriculum at XLRI Jamshedpur is approximately Rs 15 lakhs. Additional expenses will be on Hostel, Library, Alumni, Insurance, Mess, Administrative Expenses and Caution Deposit as applicable (approximately Rs.3 lakhs). The fee will be payable to XLRI.

Tuition Fee for the Curriculum at RBS, US will be approximately in the range \$52,250 at present and may likely to increase marginally. Additional Expenses will be on travel, visa, stay etc. at USA. The Fee will be payable to RBS, US.

Scholarships For Students in The Double Masters Program of XLRI and RBS

- All students of the program will be given a scholarship of \$ 12,500 by RBS during the second year at RBS
- An additional scholarship of \$2500 is given by RBS for top one third of the students in the first two terms performance at XLRI during the second year by RBS.
- RBS will also make attempts to compensate students with on-campus jobs, such as graders, course assistances, and others. However, it would not be across the board and depends on the available positions.

Note that the student will need to provide a proof of fund for approximately \$69,000 per year to attend the program (based on Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 rate). This cost is a rough estimate of total tuition, fees, and living expenses (housing, dining, and others). Another \$5,000 will be added annually for spouse and \$4,000 per child. The scholarship funds mentioned above can be part of the funding sources for the affidavit of support.

Accommodation in the US

According to USCIS, F-1 students can arrive in the U.S up to 30 days before the program starts. Most of the students choose to arrive 1-2 weeks before the semester starts.

Graduate students can either apply for on-campus housing or choose to live off-campus.

Housing Cost

Lodging expenses can range from \$8,400-\$20,000, depending on personal preferences. For example:

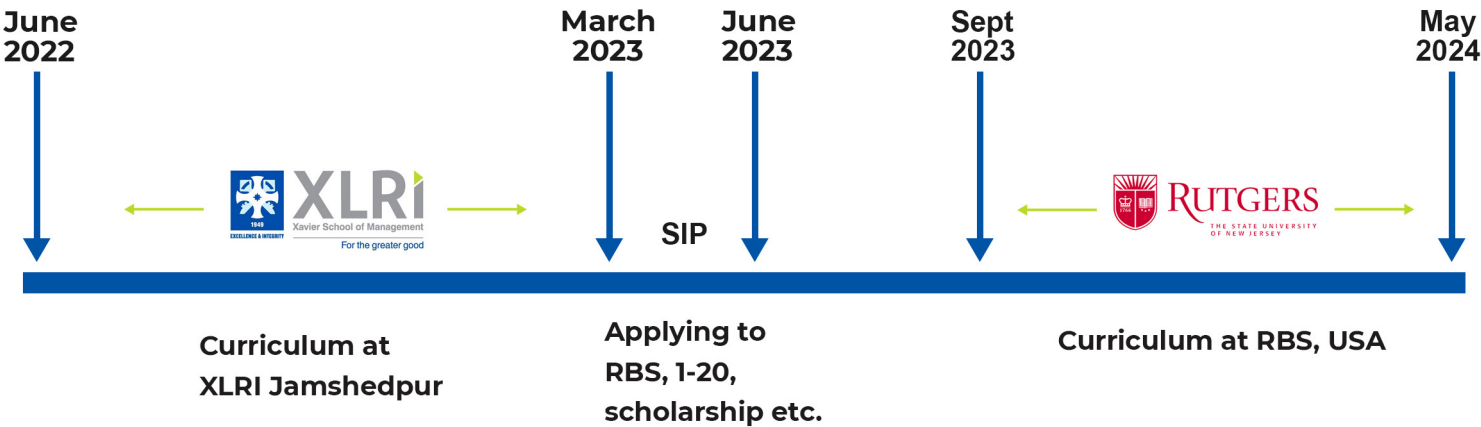
- A single one-bedroom or a studio may cost around \$18,000-\$20,000 per year.
- Sharing with one other person may cost around \$12,000-\$15,000 per year.
- One room in shared accommodation of 4 people in a house may cost around \$8,400-\$12,000 per year.
- Dining, groceries, and other essential expenses are estimated to be around \$6,000-\$8,000 per year, depending on individual lifestyles.

Note that the costs given above are only estimates from the alumni of the MSCA Program and is furnished here for information to prospective students from India to help them plan their stay. XLRI will not take responsibility for the veracity of these estimates.

” ADVANTAGE OF THE DOUBLE MASTERS PROGRAM

The main advantage of this program is the benefit of receiving two master degrees from highly ranked programs as both schools have centers of excellence in supply chain and operations

Tuition benefit for students

- A regular student in the MSCA at RBS program typically graduates in 3 semesters (September – December of next year). But, a student in this cohort will graduate in 2 semesters (September – May of next year) and an estimated saving of \$15,000 - \$21,000 (tuition, living, etc.).
- A regular student of PGDBM at XLRI spends additional 3 terms in the second year and an estimated saving of Rs.15 lakhs in Jamshedpur.

So, in two years duration, the benefit of two masters and saving of tuition fee and other expenses if spent independently on the respective programs.

Strong industry exposure to students

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PGDBM (LSCM)-MS(SCA) XLRI-RUTGERS

CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

1. Students once admitted to the program shall strictly conform to the stipulated course requirements as offered by both the Institutions and shall not be allowed to switch or shift or apply to any other program during the subsistence of the Double Masters program.
2. Students admitted to the program shall undertake to follow the rules, regulations, policies, and mandates in force at the host institution governing admissions, grades, medium of instruction, disciplinary matters, and residency norms, including but not limited to accommodations, campus life, student activities and health and safety.
3. Students admitted to the program who would be visiting Rutgers Business School, US to pursue the MS (SCA) as part of the Double Masters program shall have to apply for the MSCA Program and I-20 through their online portal as applicable to international visiting scholars with the necessary documentation required. Rutgers will facilitate assist such applicants.
4. Students who successfully apply for I-20 and fulfill all requirements laid down by Rutgers Business School shall have to apply for Visa with the US Consulate having jurisdiction. The applicant student shall be responsible for fulfilling all mandated requirements for grant of Visa, including filing of all documents required, declarations and applicable charges for such consular services. Notwithstanding anything contained hereinbefore, XLRI or Rutgers Business School shall not be responsible where Visa is denied by the Consulate.
5. Post successful completion of the XLRI-Rutgers Double Masters program, students may explore placement opportunities at Rutgers under STEM OPT Visa option as prevailing at that time and Rutgers will extend possible career counselling services to such students. Notwithstanding anything mentioned herein XLRI may consider offering career advisory and Counseling services under the program on a case to case basis.
6. Students under the Double Masters program shall also undertake to accept any modifications, alterations, change or amendment that may be effectuated on mutually agreeable terms and conditions between XLRI and Rutgers Business School (RBS) for the smooth administration of the program.
7. Without any prejudice to the foregoing clauses, XLRI & RBS reserves the right to change any or all of the program details of the Double Masters Program provided hereinbefore.

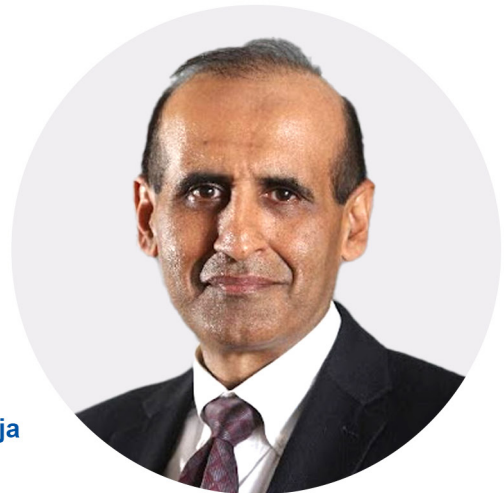
